



## GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR EXHIBITOR ENTRIES

All entries must be the original work of the Exhibitor

Ribbons will be awarded for first, second, and third place in each class. Judging is based on the quality of the work. Prize ribbons awarded by the judges will be displayed on the entries for the duration of the Fair. Some Classes may include prizes.

You do not have to be an Aldergrove resident to enter. Everyone is welcome, at any age!

**Deadline for entry forms is Thursday July 17<sup>th</sup>, 2025 at 4:00 PM.**

### Division A: EGGS

All egg entries must be from your own chickens, no store bought.

| Class 3. | Colourful eggs, any variety - 3 eggs |
| Class 4. | Biggest egg, any variety – 1 egg     |

### Division B: BAKING

NO store-bought mixes; you may enter 1 to 3 entries for each class.

All entries must have an attached label identifying the entry (e.g, Blueberry pie) baked goods on a disposable plate of appropriate size & covered with a Ziploc-type bag.

## **Division C: CANNING/PRESERVES**

All canned goods must be sealed in standard canning jars with new rings & lids. Use 125 to 500 mL jars. Rings must be loose, but seals are not broken. Canning entries may have been made last year. Hot water bath canning only. Freezer jams and pressure canning are not accepted.

- Class 1. Jams, Jellies, Spreads
- Class 2. Pickles, relishes, chutneys, salsas
- Class 3. Fruit, vegetables
- Class 4. Dried Fruit

## **Division D: CRAFTS**

This section includes useful and decorative items made completely by hand or by using only simple tools. Crafts are judged on creativity, quality of work, and pleasing aesthetics. You may enter 1 to 3 entries in each class.

- Class 1. Handmade wood, any project
- Class 2. Handmade metal, any project
- Class 3. Handmade soap, any type
- Class 4. Handmade candles, any type
- Class 5. Crochet or knit project, any type
- Class 6. Quilting, any type
- Class 7. Needlework, any type
- Class 8. Craft other (felt, weaving, etc), any type

## **Division E: GARDENING**

No commercially grown flowers, fruits, or vegetables.

- Class 1. Flower arrangement
- Class 2. Fruit or vegetable basket arrangement (home grown produce)
- Class 3. Potted plant arrangement (12" max. pot diameter) \*thriller, filler, spiller!
- Class 4. Oddest fruit or vegetable
- Class 5. Fairy Garden: using small pots & natural materials

## **Division F: UPCYCLING**

80% of the entry to be reused materials

- Class 1. Textiles
- Class 2. Other material

## **Division G: YOUTH CATEGORIES**

Open to ages 10 years and under

Please no store-bought mixes. Attach a label identifying the entry Place and cover all entries on a reusable/recyclable plate/tray of appropriate size. May enter 1 to 3 entries for each class.

- Class 1. Muffins, cookies, cake 1 kind, 3 pieces
- Class 2. Collection from nature, in a covered box or case
- Class 3. Colour picture (may be from a coloring book)
- Class 4. Crafts- made from reused wood, metal, cork, ceramics
